Amrit Mahotsav: 75 Nadi Yatra's in Maharashtra (Chala Januya Nadila)

- 2) To prepare a Current Status Report of the Respective River Basin with inputs from various River Experts and various stakeholders including common citizens. Studied inputs from Experts in the fields of Biodiversity, Aquatic life, Fisheries, Ecological flow, Waste Water treatment, solid waste, Catchment area development, Water supply dept, Sanitation Engineers, Dam Experts, Organic farmers to representing the demand side of water, Doctors studying the corelation of Pollutants and Diseases would be taken to compile this report.

This Current Status report will also take inputs from the Govt Officers of various Depts related to Water and Rivers as they are mandated to be involved in this Yatra. Sharing of their understanding, Knowledge and perspective of water and River issues will pave a way for integration of Knowledge and Experience, aspirations of civil society and Govt officers with respect to Water and River issues.
